Top Eight CATRAC M:L Cardiac Care Workgroup Goals 2011

Goal #1

- ➔ Regional hospital and EMS inventory list to include hospital designation as PCI (24/7 STEMI receiving center) or non-PCI (diagnostic cath lab or no cath lab) and key cardiac contact. Update at each quarterly meeting. (QI subgroup/EMS subgroup/Loni)

Goal #2

- ➔ To address appropriate STEMI activation of cath lab based on EMS provider impression and ECG interpretation, create plan to monitor appropriate activation based on EMS ECG interpretation. (EMS, Protocol and QI subgroups)

Goal #3

- ➔ Identify best practices for In-hospital multidisciplinary STEMI team meetings. (QI subgroup)

Goal #4

- ➔ Implement plan to educate hospital and EMS staff in region about protocols/guidelines. (EMS and Professional Education subgroups)

Goal #5

- ➔ Develop and implement plan to assist the 2 counties in our region that are interested in obtaining 12 lead ECG equipment and are interested in 12 lead ECG/STEMI education. (EMS and Professional Education subgroups)

Goal #6

- ➔ Recruit at least 3 volunteer champions from the region who would be interested in telling their story and be available for public education opportunities to provide education about heart disease warning signs/symptoms and when to call 911. (Public Education subgroup)

Goal #7

- ➔ Written regional document that includes newly developed regional guidelines, best practices, Mission: Lifeline "ideal system" criteria, etc. (Protocol subgroup/Loni)

Goal #8

- ➔ Identify community leader to assist with funding resources for regional priorities. (All)
