Minutes

Loni gave us a brief update from the Protocol and Education Committee Meetings held yesterday. The Protocol Committee is working on STEMI Referral Center only treatment protocols including medications such as Plavix 600 mg, x-ray etc... The Protocol group is also working on defining and measuring false positives? EMS will be the focus of the next Protocol meeting. The discussion will include activation of the cath lab 100% of the time from the field.

The Education group separated Public Education from Professional Education. Public Education will focus on symptom recognition by the community and Professional Education will be looking into putting together a fall regional STEMI conf.

Ronda gave an update on the Inter-facility transport service Baseline Assessment. Ronda and Traci Forister distributed 25 inter-facility transport service baseline assessments. Ronda has received 5 completed assessments as of today. Ronda will make contact with those who have not yet submitted their completed baseline assessments. Next Friday, February 26, will be the deadline for all surveys.

Louis went over goals for Mission Lifeline and what the QI committee has already accomplished. The group discussed the idea of a data registry and possibly speaking with San Antonio about what they are doing.

The QI group collectively discussed the specific STEMI Receiving Center Achievement and Reporting measures as a starting point. The group identified the data points for each measure as well as any defined barriers to implementation for each measure. Louis has created a spreadsheet which includes all of these items as a draft working document for the QI group. The goal is to have a preliminary draft set of measures, data points and identified barriers for presentation to the Cardiac Care Workgroup at the April 21 meeting.

The group learned that all of the St. David's Hospitals will be going to Action Registry and Westlake Hospital just got it approved to go over to AR as well. Now all STEMI receiving centers in our region will be participating in Action Registry.

The next QI group meeting is scheduled for March 10, 2010 from 10:00 to 11:30 am. Our meeting will follow the Protocols/Planning group meeting.
